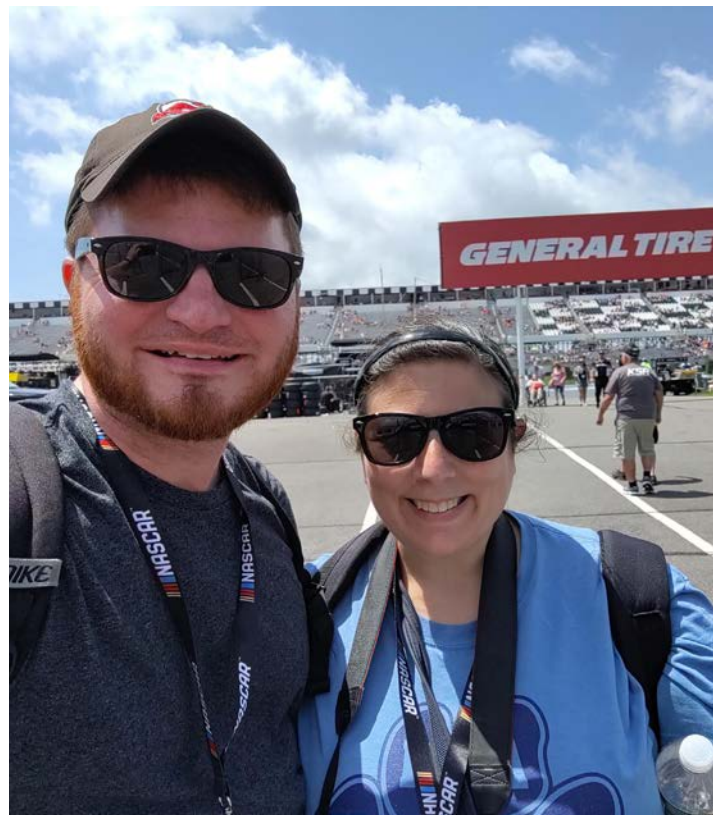

MEET *Kimberly*

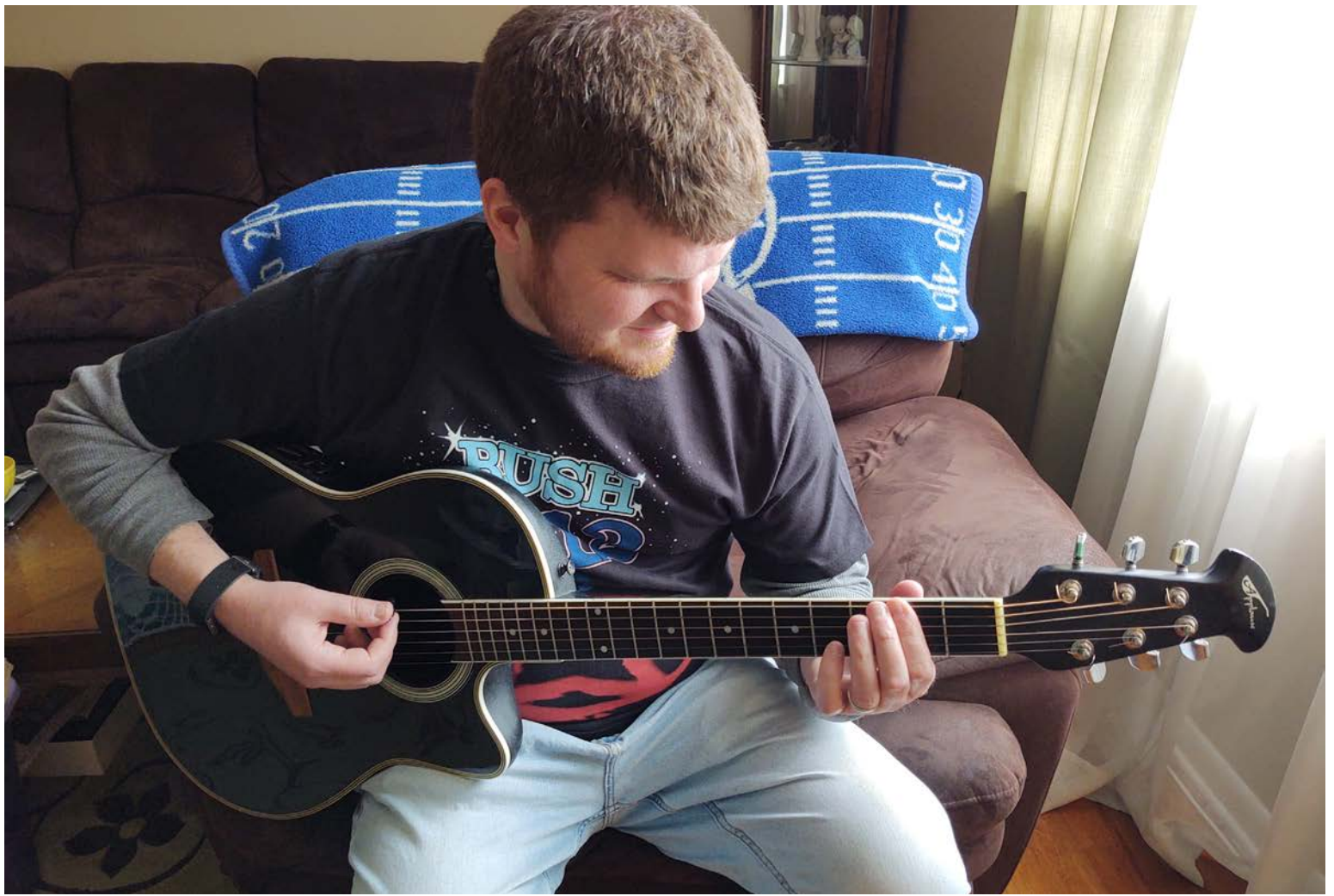

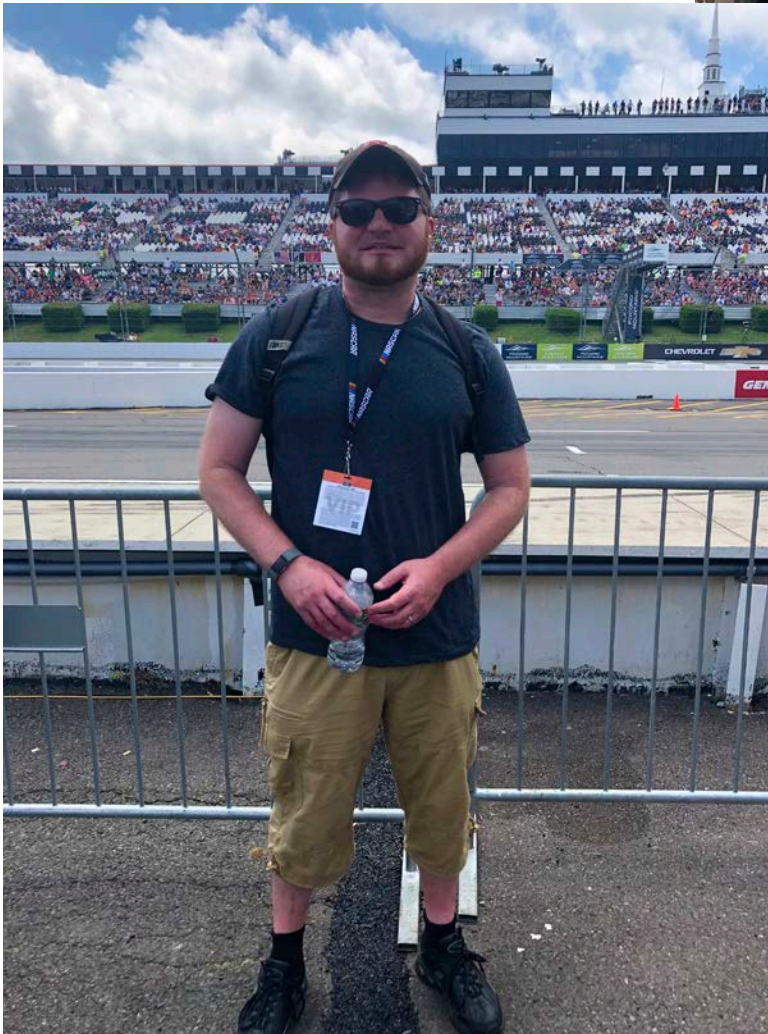
meet **DANIEL**

KIMBERLY'S SIDE

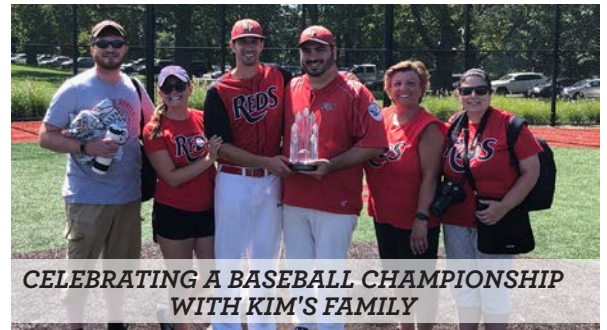

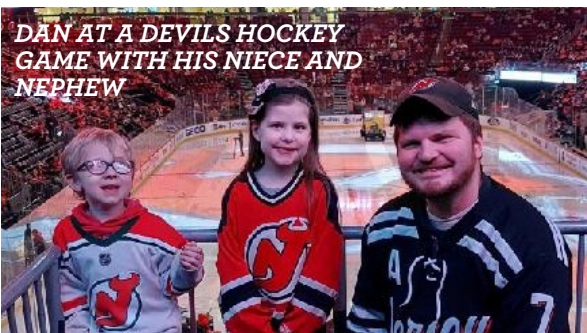
